

Battle of the Nerds 2019

Rules and Policy

1. Four teams representing various departments of CoSE will be playing:
 - A. Mathematics
 - B. Physics/Astronomy
 - C. Computer Science/Biology
 - D. Earth Sciences/Chemistry
2. This is an event designed to promote camaraderie and fun. Emphasis is NOT placed upon winning, and all competition is friendly. Aggressive/hostile behavior attitudes/play will not be tolerated and people who cannot maintain friendly and supportive behavior will be asked to leave.
3. Some departments are larger than others, and players may be redistributed to teams different from their majors.
4. The structure of the tournament is as follows for 4/19/19:

Soccer – from 5-545pm. Teams A vs D and Teams B vs C will play adjacent to one another, in a half field game. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.

Kickball – from 6-645. Teams A vs B and Teams C vs D. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.

Basketball – from 7-745. Teams A vs C and Teams B vs D. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.
5. The structure of the tournament is as follows for 4/26/19:

Soccer – from 5-545pm. Winner A/D vs Winner B/C will play for the Soccer championship. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.

Kickball – from 6-645. Winner A/B vs Winner C/D will play for the Kickball championship. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.

Basketball – from 7-745. Winner A/C vs Winner B/D will play for the Basketball championship. Winner is chosen as the highest scoring team. In the event of a tie, tie breaking shots will be taken until a winner is determined.
6. Each sport will have a final championship. Winning team will earn bragging rights and honor for their department.
7. Each team will have a student coach who will direct their team in plays.
8. Nonpartial faculty members from various departments will serve as referees.
9. Any SFSU student or faculty member is welcome and encouraged to play. Players from outside of CoSE departments will be assigned teams based on which teams have the least number of players.
10. Light snacks/refreshments will be provided.
11. Team rosters will be created to estimate team sizes prior to the event, but are not permanent and are subject to change.

12. Team t-shirts will be provided. Colors are as follows:
 - A. Math – Purple
 - B. Physics/Astronomy – Black
 - C. CS/Biology – Blue
 - D. Earth Sciences/Chemistry – Green
13. ABSOLUTELY NO alcohol or other intoxicants. People found to be violating this rule will be asked to leave immediately and banned from the championship.
14. All players must sign a waiver to play
15. All players must be an SFSU student or faculty member/staff.
16. Pictures/video will be taken. People uncomfortable with their image being used for club websites or department posters should alert Cordelia.
